- April 2007** **The Pantry, Inc.** acquired **Petro Express Inc.** and **Fast Phil's of South Carolina, Inc.**
Royal Dutch/Shell Group of Companies acquired **Shell Canada Limited**, which operated over 700 convenience stores.
- May 2007** **ExxonMobil Corporation** converted its Tigermart stores in the Memphis area to the On the Run banner.
Tesoro Corporation acquired 138 stores from **USA Petroleum Corp.** and 250 retail stations from Shell Los Angeles Refinery.
Village Pantry was spun off from former parent company Marsh Supermarkets, Inc. It now reports directly to Marsh's parent company Sun Capital Partners, Inc.
- June 2007** **Johnson Oil Co.** acquired 11-store chain **Etna Oil Company, Inc.**
Pester Marketing Company acquired 10 convenience stores from **R & C Petroleum.**
Travel Centers of America LLC acquired **Petro Stopping Centers, LP.**
Western Refining Inc. acquired **Giant Industries Inc.** and its 159 convenience stores.
- July 2007** **Giant Oil** acquired 26 stores in Ohio from **BP.**
Polk Oil Inc. was acquired by **Brookshire Brothers, Ltd.** Polk operates 29 convenience stores.
Southwest Convenience Stores, LLC acquired 102 convenience stores from **Skinny's Inc.**
- August 2007** **Quality State Oil Co., Inc.** purchased five-store chain **Ryan Oil Co** and converted the stores to the Qmart Marketplace banner.
Tri Star Energy, LLC acquired 57 Scot Markets from **Consumer Gasoline.**
Waddill's Markets, Inc. filed chapter 11 and sold all its stores to various buyers
Wooten Oil Company sold nine convenience stores to **WILCOHESS, LLC** and three to **Sampson-Bladen Oil Company, Inc.**
- October 2007** **Fas Mart Convenience Stores, Inc.** purchased 58 stores from **Barnette Enterprise Inc.**
